

Lewis-Manning Hospice Care's Virtual Glorious Dorset Gardens Competition 2020

General rules

By submitting an entry, you agree to be legally bound by the Rules and Terms and Conditions of the competition.

- The competition is open to UK residents only (including residents of the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) except any employee of the Lewis-Manning Hospice Care, excluding volunteers
- Entrants under the age of 18 years need to have parent or guardian consent to enter. Parents/guardians agree to the competition rules, terms and conditions as set out herein on behalf of the entrant.
- To enter the competition it costs £5.00 per category entry per adult and £2.50 per category entry per child (under 12).
- Garden entries must be taken in the UK, Channel Islands or the Isle of Man.
- Stock images are not eligible.
- Entrants can enter all four categories a total of one time (max. 4 entries).
- Entrants can submit up to two photos per category entry in colour or black and white.
- *• Entrants must include their name, location e.g. Wimborne, email address and contact telephone number (daytime). When emailing the image please save the file using your full name and location.

- The competition closes at 11.59pm on Tuesday 30th June 2020. Entries received after this date and time will not be considered. Any entry that is late, incomplete or inappropriate will be deemed invalid at the discretion of the Lewis-Manning Hospice Care.
