I further declare that in the event of contracting or suspecting any of the above conditions, or in the event of sickness absence over twenty consecutive days, incapacitating injury or confirmation of pregnancy, I will not fly until I have obtained medical approval.

Booking Terms and Conditions:

Please read all sections of this page carefully, before signing the declaration below

1. In order for you to recover reimbursement of the booking deposit, you must raise the minimum sponsorship level as detailed, alternatively you can donate this £50 to the charity. The full amount of £395 must be raised and paid prior to the jump taking place. Failure to raise the minimum sponsorship will result in the below named participant being invoiced for the shortfall.
2. The full amount of £395 (min sponsorship) for the Skydive, must be paid in full 1 month prior to the day of your event and this payment is totally non-refundable even if you do not complete your Skydive for any reason.
3. Should the weather be unsuitable for Skydive on the day every effort will be made to find you a suitable time to complete it on another date.
4. Deposits are non-refundable in the event of a person not arriving without appropriate notice for cancellation.
5. Cancellations or changes must be notified to Lewis-Manning Hospice 1 month prior to event day. The standard booking deposit is valid for twelve months from the date of booking and should you be unable to complete your Skydive for any reason alternatives arrangements will be made.
6. No refund or repeat attempt will be issued after a refusal to take part in the Skydive.
7. The rules and regulations of the GoSkydive team and the airfield must be adhered to at all times.
8. Due to health and safety anyone over the weight limit of 18 stone on the day of their skydive you will be unable to take part and no refund will be given. (A £10 surcharge per stone is added for participants weighing between 15 and 18 stone, and must be paid for by the participant prior to or on the day of the jump directly to Go Skydive)
9. You must arrive at the airfield at your allocated arrival time to complete the training and administration. Failure to do so may result in the loss of deposit and being unable to carry out your Skydive
10. Lewis-Manning Hospice acts as your agent in arranging your Skydive and not as the agent for the GoSkydive Team.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Skydiving is an adventure activity and participation in such necessarily involves a risk of injury or death regardless of the standard of training, supervision and equipment employed. I voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in the activity and I agree for myself and my personal representatives to indemnify and hold harmless Lewis-Manning Hospice against any claim or claims whether on my own account or from third parties arising out of any accident or incident resulting in any loss or damage (including bodily injury and death).

Disclaimer (Sky Diving)

Am I too old or too young to jump?

Our oldest jumper to date was 95 years old – so age isn't a boundary for us if it isn't for you. If you are over 40 you will need to get your GP to sign one of our British Parachute Association medical forms. Download [here](#).

You need to be at least 16 to do a tandem skydive, if you are aged between 16 and 18 you will need a parent or legal guardian to sign to give their consent. ([this form is available from the Lewis-Manning Hospice](#))

Do I weigh too much to jump?

Weight-wise 15 stone or under is the general rule but if you're reasonably fit and under 18 stone we are happy for you to jump with us. However, just like every other jumper you will be assessed by a highly qualified tandem master on the day of your jump, should he have any concerns about your ability to manoeuvre into any of the required skydiving positions you will not be able to jump. Due to higher operational costs there is a charge for any weight in excess of 15 stone. 15-16 stone £10, 16-17 stone additional £20, 17-18 stone additional £30.

Pre-jump Assessment

No matter what your age or your weight all jumpers will be assessed on the day of your jump by a tandem master. If he is not satisfied that you can manoeuvre into the required positions during freefall you will not be able to jump.

What are the freefall and landing positions?

On exit you'll need to be able to tip your head back and arch your back whilst tucking your legs up behind you. Your arms will need to be crossed, into and across your chest.

During freefall you will uncross your arms and bring them up in front of you.

As you come into land your instructor will tell you to lift your legs, you need to be able to lift your feet up to knee level whilst in a seated position. You will be able to use the fabric on the sides of your jumpsuit to assist you.

What shall I wear?

We'll supply you with a jumpsuit, goggles and a leather hat for your tandem skydive. In addition you'll need to wear trainers or similar sturdy footwear and comfortable clothes. If you are jumping outside of the high summer months or it's a cool day ensure wearing some nice warm layers and some gloves.

What about my fan club?

It's great if you can bring friends and family along to support you. There's plenty of free onsite parking and an onsite restaurant to keep energy levels up. There is also a grassed area near to the airstrip which is great for picnics. Supervised children are very welcome but the airfield is not suitable for dogs.

I need to change the date of my jump.

What is tandem skydiving weather?

Tandem Skydiving is a weather dependent activity and for your safety we can only jump when the weather conditions are suitable. We need a nice clear day with low wind levels and minimum cloud cover.

How and when will I know if the weather is suitable?

We assess the weather at 5pm on the day before your jump and will notify you as soon as possible after 5pm if we think the weather will not be suitable for jumping. We will not make any judgement on the weather prior to this time. Our website will be updated at the same time so you can also check online for a comprehensive weather check. Today's Jump Forecast

Is it safe to tandem skydive?

Like any extreme sport, tandem skydiving does have risks attached. At GoSkydive your safety is our number one priority and that is put above everything else. We are fully regulated by the British Parachute Association (BPA) and we follow their guidelines. On site our Chief Instructor (CI) ensure the BPA guidelines are adhered to at all times.

We use the very best, industry leading parachute technology – the Sigma Tandem Parachute System and have a core team of full time professional tandem skydive instructors who collectively have done in excess of 50,000 jumps.

Alcohol

If you're thinking of having a few drinks to calm your nerves – please don't. Anyone believed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted to jump. If you'd like to have a drink to celebrate post jump we are happy for you to do so.

Smoking

Smoking is permitted in the designated smoking areas if you are not wearing a skydiving jumpsuit or harness. Anyone wearing any GoSkydive kit is not permitted to smoke.

Can I film my own jump?

Only specialist trained Tandem Skydive instructors are permitted by the British Parachute Association to use cameras whilst tandem skydiving. Packages are available from £79
